GNAC Softball Championships Preview

PORTLAND, Ore. – Central Washington is the team to beat once again. And they wouldn't want it any other way.

After winning their most conference games in seven seasons and claiming their fourth consecutive regular-season title, the Wildcats are the No. 1 seed in the 2019 GNAC Softball Championships, which begins Thursday at Porter Park on the campus of Concordia University.

Picked to finish second in the GNAC Preseason Coaches Poll, Central Washington used a strong start to the season and a solid finish to clinch the sixth regular-season title in program history. After going 7-3 in non-conference play to start the season, the Wildcats won 10 straight to open the GNAC schedule. They finished with an 11-4 record in April and sewed up the regular-season crown with a doubleheader sweep of Concordia on Saturday.

The Wildcats are one of the top offensive teams in the country, leading the GNAC and ranked 13th in Division II with a .339 batting average. Central also ranks 27th nationally with 6.37 runs scored per game. Junior **Savannah Egbert** ranks fourth in the GNAC and 30th in Division II with a .444 batting average while leading the league with 71 hits. Sophomore **Katie Kastning** is hitting .403 and leads the league with 15 doubles.

In the circle, sophomore **Lexie Strasser** has won 14 games while amassing a 2.78 earned run average. At 156 innings, Strasser has the most innings pitched of any player in the tournament. Junior **Taylor Williams** owns a 3.27 earned run average and a 7-3 record.

Western Oregon has saved its best softball for the end of the season, winning six straight and seven of its last eight to earn a seventh consecutive GNAC Championships appearance. Arguably the most experienced team in the tournament field, the Wolves lead the conference with a 2.86 earned run average and a .960 fielding percentage. The team's .338 batting average is second in the GNAC and 14th in Division II.

In the circle, the Wolves depend on senior **Haley Fabian** and freshman **Madie Mayer**. Both players enter the GNAC Championships with a 2.55 earned run average, tying them for second in the GNAC. Fabian has 13 wins on the season while Mayer has 10. Mayer, however, has allowed just 17 walks in 90.2 innings of work.

Offensively, sophomore **Ayanna Arceneaux** has been the model of consistency. She enters the tournament leading the conference with a .488 batting



average, ranking her seventh in Division II. Her .535 on-base percentage ranks 22nd in Division II. Senior **Ryenne Whitaker** is hitting .393 and has stolen 22 bases. Arceneaux and Whitaker are among four WOU players with four triples on the season.

Picked to finish eighth in the GNAC Preseason Coaches Poll, Concordia also put together a strong stretch run to earn the team's first GNAC Championships berth since 2016. Concordia closed the regular season by winning five of their last seven games. The Cavaliers have thrived on pitching, ranking third in the conference with a 3.42 earned run average. Defensively sound, the Cavaliers are 12th in Division II with 0.45 double plays turned per game.

Concordia is led by dual-threat senior **Mckenzie Smith**. The utility player, who has seen starting time at pitcher, first base and

designated player, has a .319 batting average at the plate and a 3.53 earned run average in the circle. Smith is tied for second in the GNAC with 14 wins. Junior **Hannah Self** leads the Cavaliers with a .328 batting average and 12 home runs while junior **Sally Bowles** tops the team with a 3.14 earned run average. Bowles is fifth in Division II with 0.65 walks allowed per seven innings.

The defending regular season and tournament champion, Northwest Nazarene needed a split with Western Washington in the final weekend to claim the No. 4 spot in the GNAC Championships. After struggling over the first half of conference play, the Nighthawks bounced back to win eight of their last 11 to make the postseason.

The Nighthawks are third in the GNAC with a .311 batting average and are led by senior **Anna Williams**, who boasts a .418 average that is fifth in the GNAC. Williams leads the league with 54 runs and is 26th in Division II with 69 hits. Senior **Kylie Orr** is eight behind Williams with a .407 batting average.

In the circle, sophomore **Jordan Adams** continues to impress. She leads the GNAC with a 1.18 earned run average and has allowed just 34 earned runs in 131.2 innings. Her 141 strikeouts is second in the conference.

The GNAC Softball Championships begin on Thursday with No. 2 Western Oregon playing No. 3 Concordia at noon. No. 1 Central Washington and No. 4 Northwest Nazarene face off at 2:30 p.m. The championship game in the double-elimination tournament will take place on Saturday at noon. A second game, if necessary, will follow at 2:30 p.m. The winner of the GNAC Championships receives the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Division II Softball Championship.

Around The GNAC

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



- Central Washington secured its fourth consecutive GNAC regular-season championship with a split last weekend. The Wildcats took a pair of wins from Concordia on Saturday, 3-0 and 12-4 (5 innings). Central took two losses at Western Oregon on Sunday, 4-3 and 8-4.
- Senior **Kayla Smith** was named the GNAC Softball Player of the Week for her offensive efforts in the final weekend of the regular season. Smith finished with a .636 batting average, going 7 for 11 in the four road games with a run, three RBI and two stolen bases. Smith went 2 for 3 in both of Saturday's wins over Concordia and scored a run in the second game. Smith went 1 for 2 in Sunday's opener at Western Oregon, which included an RBI single in the first and a sacrifice fly, and went 2 for 3 with an RBI single in the nightcap. Smith enters the week with a .350 batting average.
- Sophomore **Katie Kastning** hit .643 in the four games, going 9 for 14 with six runs and nine RBI. She opened by going 3 for 4 with all three RBI in Saturday's opener with Concordia and went 2 for 3 with two runs and an RBI single in the nightcap. On Sunday, Kastning went 2 for 4 with two runs and an RBI triple in the opener and was 2 for 3 in the nightcap. Kastning is seventh in the GNAC with a .403 batting average and leads the league with 15 doubles.
- Sophomore **Lexie Strasser** went 1-1 last weekend while compiling a 1.62 earned run average. She was the winner in Saturday's 3-0 opener with Concordia, allowing four hits and a walk while striking out five. Strasser is sixth in the GNAC with a 2.78 earned run average.
- Central Washington leads the GNAC and is 13th in Division II with a .339 batting average. The Wildcats rank 27th in Division II in scoring (6.37 per game) and 28th in on-base percentage (.402). Individually, junior **Savannah Egbert** is 18th in Division II with 71 hits and 30th with a .444 batting average.

CONCORDIA



- After being picked eighth in the GNAC Preseason Poll, Concordia split their weekend games to secure the No. 3 seed in the GNAC Championships. The Cavaliers dropped two games to Central Washington on Saturday, 3-0 and 12-4 (5 innings), before beating Saint Martin's twice on Sunday, 4-2 and 8-0 (5 innings).
- Junior **Hannah Self** led the way for the Cavaliers offensively with a .400 batting average, going 4 for 10 with a run, three RBI and two doubles. After collecting a hit and a sacrifice fly in the second game against Central Washington, Self went 2 for 3 in the opener against Saint Martin's and opened the second game with a two-RBI double. Self leads the Cavaliers with a .328 batting average and is third in the GNAC with 12 home runs.
- Senior **Mckenzie Smith** amassed a 1.62 earned run average while going 1-1 last week. Smith lasted 3.2 innings in the second game against CWU, allowing four runs, two earned, on six hits with a strikeout. Smith was the winner in Sunday's 8-0 five-inning shutout of SMU, allowing three hits and striking out one. Smith enters the week with a 3.53 earned run average and a .319 batting average.
- Junior **Sally Bowles** collected the loss in Saturday's opening-game loss to CWU and then earned the win in Sunday's opener with SMU, allowing two runs, one earned, on six hits with a walk and two strikeouts in six innings. Bowles is seventh in the GNAC with a 3.14 earned run average and is fifth in Division II with 0.65 walks allowed per seven innings.
- Concordia enters the GNAC Championships with a .287 batting average and is third in the GNAC with a 3.42 earned run average. The Cavaliers are 12th in Division II with 0.45 double plays turned per game.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene secured the No. 4 seed in the GNAC Championships thanks to a split with Western Washington. The Nighthawks won game one of both doubleheaders, 7-0 on Friday and 8-7 on Saturday.
- Senior **Shelbie Martinez** batted .462 in the four games to lead NNU, going 6 for 13 with four RBI. Martinez went 2 for 3 and had a two-RBI single that opened scoring in Friday's first game and then went 2 for 3 with an RBI single and a sacrifice fly in Saturday's opener. Martinez had single hits in both losses. Martinez enters the week with a .267 batting average.
- Senior **Anna Williams** had a .429 batting average in the WWU series, going 6 for 14 with five runs, four RBI, a double, a triple and a home run. Williams went 2 for 3 with a two-RBI triple in Friday's opener and then went 2 for 4 in Saturday's opener with a solo home run and an RBI single. Williams also had single hits in both losses. Williams leads NNU with a .418 batting average. She is sixth in Division II with 128 total bases and 29th with 13 home runs.
- Senior **Rylee Thomas** allowed seven runs, six earned, on 16 hits with eight strikeouts in 14 innings against the Vikings. She picked up the win in Friday's opener as she allowed just three hits and one walk while striking out four to improve to 8-8 on the season. Thomas enters the week with a 4.19 earned run average. Sophomore **Jordan Adams** leads the GNAC with a 1.87 earned run average to go along with 141 strikeouts.
- The Nighthawks enter the GNAC Championships third in the GNAC with a .311 batting average to go with a 3.83 earned run average. The Nighthawks are second in the league with a .956 fielding percentage.

WESTERN OREGON



- Western Oregon has now won seven straight games and secured the No. 2 seed in the GNAC Championships with a weekend sweep. The Wolves took 7-1 and 13-2 (5 innings) wins from Saint Martin's on Saturday along with 4-3 and 8-4 victories from Central Washington on Sunday.
- Senior **Haley Fabian** was named the GNAC Pitcher of the Week after she pitched the Wolves to two wins. Fabian went the distance in a 7-1 win over Saint Martin's on Saturday, allowing one run on five hits with seven strikeouts. She then tossed a complete-game 4-3 win over Central Washington on Sunday, allowing three runs, two earned, on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts. Fabian enters the week with a 2.55 earned run average and a 13-3 record.
- Sophomore **Ayanna Arceneaux** finished with a .600 batting average in the four games, going 6 for 10 with four runs, three RBI and a home run. Arceneaux went 2 for 2 in Saturday's opener and then smashed a three-run homer in the second game. Arceneaux went 1 for 3 in Sunday's opener with CWU and went 2 for 4 in the nightcap. Arceneaux leads the GNAC and is seventh in Division II with a .488 batting average. She is also 22nd in Division II with a .535 on-base percentage.
- Senior **Cheyenne Rimer** batted .462 in the four games and had four runs and four RBI. She went 2 for 4 with a two-run single in Saturday's opener with SMU and went 2 for 4 with a two-run homer in the nightcap. Rimer enters the week with a .367 batting average.
- The Wolves enter the week second in the GNAC and 14th in Division II with a .338 batting average. The Wolves lead the GNAC with a 2.86 earned run average and have allowed the fewest runs (154) and hits (312) of any team in the league. Western also leads the GNAC with a .960 fielding percentage and is 27th in Division II with a .403 on-base percentage.
