**THE DORMEYER SYSTEM:** The GNAC is now in the third year of figuring the results of the All-Sports Trophy using the Dormeyer System. The score is an average based on each school's final placing in each conference sport. Teams receive 10 points for a first-place finish with subsequent teams receiving a score based on the number of teams that participate in that sport. Scores are based on final regular-season placing in baseball, men's and women's basketball, football, men's and women's soccer, softball and volleyball; and final placing in conference tournaments/meets in men's and women's cross country, men's and women's golf, men's & women's indoor track and field and men's and women's outdoor track and field.
