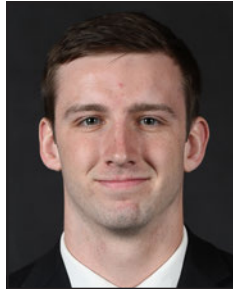

OFFENSIVE

Rylan Wells, Jacksonville

Senior (RS) | Quarterback
Tega City, South Carolina

Wells posted his second five-touchdown performance of 2017 leading Jacksonville to a 35-21 PFL victory against Davidson, Saturday. Dropping back, Wells went 11-for-18 passing for 249 yards and threw two touchdowns. But he was as impressive on the ground with 18 carries for 99 yards and three touchdowns. Wells scored the game's first touchdown with a 45-yard run. He then led the Dolphins on scoring drives of 95 and 93 yards, extending the lead to 21-0. Wells tacked on a 38-yard scoring run before halftime and then a 14-yard touchdown pass in the third quarter. In addition, Wells punted twice and averaged 35 yards per punt with one downed inside the Wildcats' 20-yard line.

DEFENSIVE

Tim Simon, Dayton

Freshman (RS) | Safety
Mortin Grove, Illinois

Making his first appearance on defense this season, Simon picked off two passes to pace Dayton's defense in a 20-10 PFL victory against Drake, Saturday. His two interceptions were the bulk of a four-interception day by the Flyers and helped limit Drake's passing game to just 12 completions on 40 pass attempts. His first interception came on the second play of the fourth quarter and he returned it 28 yards to set up the Dayton offense. Simon's second pick ended Drake's next-to-last drive. He also was credited with two tackles and a pass breakup.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Sean Smith, Dayton

Junior | Kicker
Avandale, Pennsylvania

Smith averaged 43 yards per punt to help Dayton down Drake, 20-10, in PFL action, Saturday. Five of his seven punts were downed inside the Drake 20-yard line with two punts going for more than 50 yards. Smith punted three times from inside Drake territory but when punting from inside his own 25 he boomed an average of 56.7 yards on three punts. Drake attempted just one return on his seven punts but muffed the catch and the ball was recovered by Dayton.

OTHER TOP PERFORMANCES

- **XAVIER COLVIN, LB (Butler)** – Colvin had just five tackles in Butler's win but two of those were sacks, including a strip-sack on the game's opening drive, and also had a fumble recovery in the second quarter to set up another scoring drive.
- **MATIAS GASC, P (Stetson)** – Averaged 43 yards on his four punts, including a 46 yarder, and saw one downed inside the Brown 20-yard line in a Stetson win.
- **ALEX JESKE, QB (Dayton)** – Making his season's first start, Jeske ran for a touchdown and passed for another, completing 12-of-20 passes for 197 yards, leading Dayton to its first PFL win this season.
- **COLIN McGOVERN, QB (Stetson)** – Despite playing without his two leading receivers, McGovern completed 26 of 36 passes for 269 yards and no interceptions and ran for two touchdowns in Stetson's first win.
- **CARLOS MERRITT, DB (Campbell)** – Merritt racked up 10 tackles in Campbell's win and intercepted a pass for the third consecutive game.
- **DANIEL SMITH, QB (Campbell)** – Smith threw for four touchdowns and ran for another in Campbell's win, completing 18-of-27 passes for 257 yards.
- **TREVOR SMITH, K (Davidson)** – Smith converted on each of his three PATs and recovered his own onside kick to help set up the Wildcats second touchdown of the contest.

NEWS AND NOTES FROM AROUND THE PFL

PFL's 25TH CAMPAIGN | The 2017 season marks the 25th year for the Pioneer Football League – the nation's only non-scholarship, football-only NCAA Football Championship Sub-division conference. The league will feature 11 teams each playing an eight-game schedule to determine the league champion and recipient of the automatic bid to the 2017 NCAA FCS Championship.

SAN DIEGO ON CUSP OF RECORD | San Diego, which has won 15 consecutive PFL contests, returns to action in Week 7 needing one win to break the PFL record for consecutive league wins – a record it currently holds. The Toreros won 15 consecutive PFL contests during the 2005-07 seasons, including an unbeaten 2006 PFL title campaign.

HELLO OLD FRIEND | Week 6 across the PFL will feature four contests that will pit teams against one another for the first time since 2014. The league's biennial schedule rotation will see Jacksonville-Butler, Campbell-Dayton, Marist-Valparaiso and Morehead State-San Diego matchups return to the fold this season.

DARE TO LOOK AHEAD | With three league unbeaten at the season's halfway point, the wait for further clarity in the PFL championship race may not have to wait beyond October. Jacksonville will have the honor of facing the other two unbeaten squads in Weeks 8 and 9, hosting San Diego (Oct. 21) before traveling to Campbell (Oct. 28). However, San Diego and Campbell do not face each other in 2016, leaving the possibility the league's tiebreaker may be called into action at season's end if the Dolphins cannot take control themselves.

DAYTON'S CHAMBERLIN BREAKS MENTOR'S MARK | Dayton head coach Rich Chamberlin notched his 56th PFL victory in his 75th league game, Oct. 7, when the Flyers defeated Drake. He broke the PFL record for coaching victories set by his former head coach Mike Kelley, who posted 55 league wins (71 games) during his storied career. They are the only two coaches in PFL history to record 50 league wins.

SMITH PUNTS WAY TO NATIONAL HONOR | Dayton junior kicker Sean Smith became the second PFL athlete to earn national weekly honors, Oct. 8, when he was named the STATS FCS Special Teams Player of the Week. His 43.0 yards per punt against Drake saw five of his seven tries downed inside the Drake 20-yard line and two booming for more than 50 yards.

DOLPHINS DO RUN | A quick look at the NCAA FCS team leaders reveals Jacksonville's offense is the subdivision's leading rushing offense, averaging 318.6 yards per game on the ground. The Dolphins rank fifth in rush attempts (275) and 14th in yards per rush (5.63). Jacksonville has three runners ranked among the FCS Top 100 in yards per game and five ranked among the Top 150.

CAMELS DEFEND | Meanwhile, Campbell enters the season's second half ranked No. 5 among FCS teams in both total defense (258.3 ypg) and scoring defense (12.5 ppg). Both those Top 5 rankings are due largely to its No. 2 ranking in third-down defense (22.5%) and owning the nation's best red-zone defense, which has allowed opponent's just seven scores in a meager 14 opportunities.

TOREROS PETERSEN LEADS THE CHARGE | San Diego defensive lineman Jonathan Petersen continues to be a force, entering the season's second half ranked in the FCS Top 5 in both sacks (t-3rd, 1.20 pg) and tackles for loss (5th, 1.9 pg). Among FCS active career leaders, he ranks No. 1 in total sacks per game (0.80) and No. 2 in tackles for loss per game (1.46).

FRESHMAN RUSHING LEADERS | The PFL's youth has run rampant in the season's first half, as Campbell redshirt freshman quarterback Daniel Smith leads the league with 106.8 yards per game (10th in FCS). Davidson freshman running back Wesley Dugger is 17th nationally at 95.0 yards per game. And proving age has its worth, Dayton senior running back Tucker Yinger rounds out a trio of PFL runner in the FCS Top 20 with his 94.0 yards per game (19th).

OPPORTUNISTIC CAMELS AND RED FOXES | Campbell and Marist are among a group of just 25 FCS teams with multiple defensive touchdowns this season. The Camels lead the FCS with four defensive scores (two interceptions, two fumbles). Marist has two defensive touchdowns (one interception, one fumble) and is tied for 11th among FCS squads.

QUARTET OF KICK RETURNERS TO FEAR | The PFL boasts four kick returners that have proven to be dangerous in 2017. Morehead State's Jaunyea Tarver (1st, 634 yards), Valparaiso's Bailey Gessinger (5th, 530), Dayton's Christian Searles (26th, 377) and Butler's Cam Cooper (31st, 353) are each ranked among the FCS Top 40 in Combined Kick Return Yardage (punt and kick returns).

WEEKLY AWARDS

The PFL names Offensive, Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week each Sunday during the season. Winners are selected from nominations provided by each PFL team's Football Media Relations personnel. 2017 PIONEER FOOTBALL LEAGUE WEEKLY REPORT

MARIST'S JOHNSON 1ST TO RETURN KICK FOR SCORE |

Marist's Mekhai Johnson became the first PFL return specialist to return a kickoff for a touchdown in 2017, turning in the score against Jacksonville in Week 4. He was one of only 13 FCS players to return a kick for a touchdown in the season's first four weeks.

RETURNS TO THE HOUSE |

Three of the 26 FCS return men to take a punt back for a touchdown reside in the PFL. Davidson's Austin Wells, Dayton's Christian Searles and Campbell's Jaquan Brooks have each put six on the board after fielding a punt in 2017.

HIGGINBOTHOM, PRIEST LEADS RECEIVERS |

Morehead State's Jaren Higginbothom and San Diego's Justin Priest each have five receiving touchdowns this season, ranking 14th among FCS athletes in the category.

SIX PFL STUDENT-ATHLETES NAMED CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALISTS |

Campbell kicker/punter Brian Stryffeler, Davidson quarterback Taylor Mitchell, Dayton linebacker Jack Crain, Marist running back Marcellus Calhoun, San Diego nickelback Max Michaels and Stetson tight end Austin Tyrrell were among 181 semifinalists for the Campbell Trophy which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation and is prominently displayed inside its official home at the New York Athletic Club.

WOODS FIRST PFL ATHLETE TO EARN NATIONAL HONOR |

Campbell running back Montel Goods became the first Pioneer Football League athlete to earn a weekly national honor in 2017, earning STATS FCS National Freshman of the Week, Monday. His three touchdown outing moved him atop the PFL leaderboard in rushing touchdowns this season, his five scores matching Valparaiso's Cody Boxrucker with both ranked 11th among FCS runners.

NEW NAME FOR BUTLER HOME FACILITY |

The longtime home for Butler football received a new name in September when the Butler Bowl was renamed the Sellick Bowl in honor of longtime supporters Winstan and Jacqueline Sellick. The renaming was in recognition of a \$9.4-million gift from their estate to the university, shared among the athletics department, the Lacy School of Business and the university.

FIVE PFL ALUMNI ON NFL ACTIVE ROSTERS |

The opening week of NFL action saw five PFL alumni listed on NFL active rosters. Marist alumni Terrence Fede (Miami) and Jason Myers (Jacksonville) returned to their teams for 2017. Drake's Eric Saubert (Atlanta), San Diego's Jamal Agnew (Detroit) and Stetson's Donald Payne (Jacksonville) are the league's newest alumni to make an NFL roster in 2017.

EIGHT FIRST-TEAM ALL-PFL RETURNEES HIGHLIGHT PRE-SEASON SQUAD |

San Diego, the defending PFL Champion, returns four First-Team All-PFL selections among its seven preseason picks, including quarterback Anthony Lawrence. Dayton, last season's PFL runner up, had two returning first-team selections on the team while Campbell and Marist return one first-teamer each.

SAN DIEGO PICKED TO WIN PFL |

For the seventh consecutive year, the University of San Diego has been picked to win the Pioneer Football League regular-season race in a preseason vote of the league's coaches. San Diego, which won the 2016 regular-season title then advanced to the second round of the FCS Championship, again received the coaches' nod to win the 2017 PFL title. The Toreros were chosen just ahead of Dayton in polling that was dominated by the two teams. San Diego and Dayton combined to receive all available first-place votes and also claimed all but two of the possible second-place votes.

DAYTON'S SCORING STREAK HITS 460 GAMES |

The nation's longest streak of games without being shutout belongs to Dayton, which extended the streak to 460 games in its Week 4 loss against Morehead State. That streak includes 265 games as a FCS member, which ranks fourth all-time among FCS programs. Montana holds the FCS' longest streak without being shutout at 373 games which dates back to 1989. On the FBS side, Florida holds the nation's longest streak of games without being shutout at 364, dating back to the 1988 season. The Flyers streak dates back to 1976 when it suffered a 9-0 loss to Marshall.

TWO PFL ALUMNI SELECTED IN 2017 NFL DRAFT |

In a milestone moment for the Pioneer Football League, Drake tight end Eric Saubert and San Diego defensive back Jamal Agnew were each selected in the fifth round of the 2017 NFL Draft. The PFL was one of five Division I FCS conferences to have two players selected in the draft. The PFL joined the Colonial Athletic Association, Big Sky Conference, Missouri Valley Football Conference and the Southwestern Athletic Conference with two selections while the entire FCS saw 15 players drafted.

SAN DIEGO'S LAWRENCE NAMED TO PAYTON WATCH LIST |

San Diego junior quarterback Anthony Lawrence, a nominee for the 2016 Walter Payton Award Watch List a year ago, is one of 22 players on the 2017 preseason watch list for the 2017 STATS FCS Walter Payton Award. As a sophomore, he helped the Toreros to an undefeated league record and then an FCS playoff win over Cal Poly that was the first in PFL history. Lawrence ranked fourth in the FCS in completion percentage (67.6) and eighth in passing efficiency rating (155.0) while throwing for 2,998 yards and 25 touchdowns against eight interceptions.

THREE NAMED TO STATS FCS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA SQUADS |

Three Pioneer Football League student athletes were among the 100 named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Team. San Diego junior offensive lineman Daniel Cooney was a second-team selection while teammate senior defensive lineman Jonathan Petersen was joined on the third team by Drake punt returner Terry Wallen.

FIVE PFL ATHLETES NOMINATED FOR 2015 ALLSTATE AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM |

Three Pioneer Football League student athletes were among 146 nominees from across the country for the 26th edition of the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®. Isaak Newhouse (Butler), Ryan Samuels (Davidson) and Lawrence Dickens (Marist) were nominated for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®. In order to meet the criteria set forth by Allstate and the AFCA, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining a strong academic standing.

TOREROS CHARGE TO 2016 FCS OPENING ROUND WIN |

San Diego became the first PFL team to win a game in the Division I Football Championship with its 35-21 victory at Cal Poly, last season. The Toreros win came in just the fourth season of the PFL's automatic bid into the championship.
